Entry conditions for project presentations in the project market

Application

Individuals, NGOs, foundations, associations and responsible bodies from school, non-formal and informal citizenship education can apply for participation in the project market. Educational projects, which are still in process, may also apply. Projects should not be older than two years.

The most outstanding projects and approaches can present themselves at the project market of this year's NECE Conference in Glasgow.

The NECE Initiative cannot assume any costs for travel and accommodation.

The NECE Initiative will provide a table and a pin board and Wi-Fi for each exhibition booth.


Presence at and opening hours of the project market

As the project market is intended as an exchange forum for presentation, networking, discussion and cooperation, please be prepared to present your project to the audience at the project market. The presentation will take place during the project market sessions on Thursday, 24 October from 2:30 pm to 04:00 pm, on Friday 25 October from 9.00 to 9:30 am and from 1.30 to 2.30 pm as well as on Saturday 26 October from 9.00 to 09:30 am and from 1.00 to 2.00 pm. During these times, your exhibition booth should be occupied by you / the person presenting the project.

Apart from the presentation at the project booth, representatives will be invited to present their project to the audience in the plenary during an elevator pitch on Friday 25 October between 9.00 and 9.30 am.

The project market will be opened on Thursday, 24 October 2019. The set-up of the project market will take place on Thursday before the conference opening, the removal will be on Saturday 26 October from 2.00 pm (details will follow soon).





Application is possible by filling out the project market application in the conference online registration tool only.
