4	Brief description of project	The individual districts of Warsaw are very varied by the economic and social development. This project is addressed to schools acting in societies with big unemployment, social pathologies and families with parental care problems. Schools and teachers do not manage with these issues. Teachers do not have enough abilities to work effectively with neglected students, having development deficits with no support from the family side. Project assumes formulation of the wide program of support for the whole school society by the teacher competences training.
