



On the trail of rumours

In 2016, rumours and lies about the LGBTQ+ community began to spread in Taiwan like wildfire.




To help build a trustworthy environment for public discourse, they created Cofacts - an online fact-checking platform.

Everyone likes to share content.

The more sensational it is, the more we might share it with others.



But how do we know if it's actually true?



Especially in election times, false and misleading info about pressing social issues often increases, leaving us confused or even divided.

HOW IT WORKS:**


When you stumble upon information you are unsure about in LINE messenger...



[1] You can forward it to the Cofacts bot.



[2] The bot will search its database and return the results after verification.




[3] If the database doesn't have enough information, it will send it to volunteers who fact-check it and add verified details.



[4] If there is no simple answer, you get several options. By rating the answers based on clarity, helpfulness, and authenticity, you can help the database determine the best answer.

Cofacts hopes to increase critical thinking about the content we receive and disseminate.



Cofacts has made the source code open.

So, everyone can use the code to program their own chatbots for messengers like LINE.





Still, Cofacts continues to aim to facilitate dialogue and to help rebuild trust in society at large.
