1	Title of project	VOICE. Developing citizens
2	Location	Austria, Estonia, Germany, Slovenia, Turkey
3	Main topics/ key words	Key competences, problem-learning, citizenship education
4	Brief description of project	Comenius multilateral project's consortium is developing an innovative strategy for Education for Democratic Citizenship in secondary and post secondary (vocational) schools, in which both civic engagement and learning-to-learn key competences are improved and enhanced. Additionally, developing a model in-service teacher training course which focuses on necessary EDC/HRE background knowledge and methodological tools for teachers in secondary and vocational schools needed to get familiar with competence-orientated civic education.
5	Objectives of project	Development of students' competencies through use of problem-based learning/ teaching modules and teacher training course. The focus is especially on enhancing social, civic and learning-to-learn skills and this should be done through classes held on citizenship/ civics or related (depending on the country's situation in formal curricula).
6	Effect on the empowerment of educationally disadvantaged groups	According to the preparatory national survey, students in Slovenian vocational schools are 70% rated as "lacking basic social, civic and learning-to-learn skills," which is a huge disadvantage for their future professional life as well as for their future engagement into society as active citizens, able to form and follow democratic procedures.
7	Target Groups	In Slovenia, vocational schools that offer a module on EDC in their open curricula. Their students mainly come from disadvantaged rural and lower working-class families and represent many nationalities (minorities), including Roma, Kosovo Albanians, Bosnians, Serbs and many drop-out students from other schools.
